

Advertisement for Bids

Sealed proposals for construction of the Lower Rio Grande Public Water Works Authority Water Berino Area Waterline Extensions will be received by Parkhill, Smith & Cooper at 115 West Griggs Avenue, Las Cruces, New Mexico, until 2:00 p.m. (MST), Wednesday June 21, 2017, and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after the bid opening begins will not be accepted.

The work under this contract shall be for furnishing all labor, materials, transportation and services for the construction and installation of the following work compiled in a base bid with three additive alternates, with the priority of selection placed in the same order, to include:

Provide a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan to cover the entire project. Provide Traffic Control for the work covered under the Base Bid and each Additive Alternate. Perform seven tie-ins. Install six 6-inch resilient wedge gate valves. Install one 8-inch resilient wedge gate valve. Install 14,730 linear feet of 6-inch water line. Install 730 linear feet of 8-inch water line. Install 30 linear feet of 6-inch ductile iron water line. Install 15 linear feet of 8-inch ductile iron water line. Place 50 cubic yards of 1-sack flowable fill. Install 25 linear feet of 14-inch steel bore casing. Install 580 linear feet of 3-inch HDPE service line casing, directionally drilled or bored. Install 760 linear feet of 3/4-inch water service pipe, not requiring excavation. Install 150 linear feet of 1-inch water service pipe, not requiring excavation. Install 575 linear feet of 3/4-inch water service pipe, requiring excavation. Install thirty six (51) 5/8-inch meter assemblies, inclusive of tap & saddle, corporation stop, meter setter, and all appurtenances excluding service pipe. Install three 1-inch meter assemblies, inclusive of tap & saddle, corporation stop, meter setter, and all appurtenances excluding service pipe. Install 15 fire hydrant assemblies. Install seventeen 1-inch air release valve assemblies. Install two sampling stations. Install 320 square yards of 2-inch thick hot mix asphalt concrete. Install 210 square yards of 6-inch thick base course. Provide a New Mexico Department of Transportation record drawing survey on the New Mexico Highway 28 portion of the project. Provide an hourly cost for an allowance of up to 11 hours of exploration time.

There is no cost or deposit required for these two options. A payment of \$55.00, in cashier's check or money order, payable to Parkhill, Smith & Cooper, Inc. will be required for each set of printed Contract Documents. This payment will be refunded in full if the printed Contract Documents are returned to PSC within two weeks of bid opening.

A pre-bid meeting will be held 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday June 13, 2017 at the Lower Rio Grande Public Water Works Authority La Mesa Office, 521 St. Valentine, La Mesa, New Mexico. All questions are to be sent to Dan Robillard at drobillard@team-psc.com, no later than Friday June 16, 2017.

Each Bid shall be submitted in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders and be accompanied by a Bid Security in the amount of five percent (5%) of the bid amount. All bidders shall hold their bids for Sixty one (61) days after actual date of bid opening.

The Successful Bidder states he or she must furnish 100 percent (100%) Performance Bond and a 100 percent (100%) Payment Bond in accordance to the Instructions to Bidders and the General Conditions.

By submission of the bid, Bidder fully understands the requirements of the Contract Documents and agrees to comply with all requirements thereof.

Wages paid on this project shall not be less that the minimum prevailing rates listed in the Contract Documents, Section 00200, Wage Rates.

The Authority reserves the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive informalities or irregularities in the Bidding.
